Introduction John 14: 15 - 26

Hook:	Share with your group a time in your life when you felt helpless.
Head:	<ul> <li>What is the trinity?</li> <li>How is love for Jesus evidenced?</li> <li>How does the Holy Spirit continue the work of Christ? (Steve gave us two areas of importance.)</li> <li>What does it mean that the Holy Spirit is the Spirit of truth?</li> <li>The Greek word used for the Holy Spirit in verse 16 is the word, <i>paraclete</i>. How is this word translated in your Bible?</li> <li>How is Jesus' promise of the Holy Spirit different from the momentary examples of the Holy Spirit we see in the Old Testament?</li> </ul>
Heart:	Jesus said that if we love Him, we will keep His commandments. Think about some of those. Which are the most difficult to obey? How does the Holy Spirit help us do what God has called us to do? How do we know that the Holy Spirit is at work in our lives? Why does Jesus refer to the Holy Spirit as "another Helper" rather than "the" Helper? Steve mentioned two ways that the Holy Spirit is like Jesus. He is personal and He is God. How do we see the personal nature of the Holy Spirit in Scripture? What does it mean to be led by the Spirit? How can this get sideways in the life of a believer?
