John 12: 31 - 33

Hook:

Share with your group Easter traditions from your family.

Head:

How did the people respond to Jesus' miracle of raising Lazarus from the dead?

How did the religious leaders respond?

What impact did that event have on what we know as the Triumphal Entry?

What does Jesus say in John 12: 23? How is this different than the other instances where Jesus mentions His hour?

What do verses 27 and 28 tell us about Jesus' understanding of what is about to happen?

In verse 32, Jesus mentions that He will draw all men unto Himself? Does this mean we're universalists? If so, why? If not, what does it mean?

Heart:

Sometimes people offend or hurt us unintentionally. Other times, those attacks are personal. Why do offenses that are personal hurt worse?

Steve mentioned that Jesus' death was personal. What did he mean by that?

How does the cross function as judgment and grace at the same time?

Have you ever been in a place where the presence of God and the providence of God didn't make sense? What was that like?

How does seeing Jesus "lifted up" change my view of suffering, sacrifice, and glory?

What are things you can do this week to help you understand more of what Jesus' death on the cross means and why it matters?
